








Transportation Management Organizations






- Express Bus Service from Distant Suburban/Rural Communities to Downtown

Van-GO! Program flexibility

- Choice of four van sizes -7,9,12,15 passenger vans
- Van lease is monthly
- Route, stops, schedule and fare determined by poolers





Van-GO! Results

- 71 vanpools
- Ridership: 209,810
- Subsidy per pass: \$2.93
- Annual System miles: 1,247,595
- 52% Farebox Recovery
